On February 15, 2013, the Reporting Person was awarded 18,001 target performance stock units (as adjusted for the spin-off of Time Inc.) with a three-year performance period ending December 31, 2015. As previously reported on a Form 4 (filed with the SEC on January 28, 2016), on January 27, 2016, the Compensation and Human Development Committee approved a payout of 189.8% of the

- target PSUs under the performance standards set in 2013, based on (i) the Issuer's cumulative Adjusted EPS achieved during the performance period, which resulted in an Adjusted EPS factor of 183%, and (ii) its total stockholder return for the performance period compared to other companies in the S&P 500, which resulted in a TSR modifier of 103.7%. The PSU payout factor is determined by multiplying the Adjusted EPS factor and the TSR modifier. On February 15, 2016, the Reporting Person acquired 34,165 shares of common stock upon the vesting of the performance stock units.
- (2) Each performance stock unit or restricted stock unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of common stock. The Reporting Person received one share of common stock for each performance stock unit or restricted stock unit that vested.
