On August 9, 2006, a shareholder derivative complaint was filed in San Mateo Superior Court, purportedly on behalf of Electronic Arts Inc. (the Company), against certain current and former officers and directors. The complaint, styled *Plumbers & Pipefitters Local No. 572 Pension Fund v. Probst, et al.*, alleges, among other things, purported improprieties in the Company's issuance of stock options.

The Company does not intend to file further current reports on Form 8-K describing additional lawsuits, if any, which are based on allegations substantially similar to those contained in the complaint described herein.
