On May 29, 2009 Tara Gold Resources exchanged 1,500,000 shares of the issuer for 2,147,750 shares of the common stock of Tara Minerals Corp. The shares of Tara Minerals Corp. were held by nine persons who were not affiliated with Tara Gold Resources or Tara Minerals Corp. Tara Minerals
