Legal Proceedings

On August 28, 2006, Kookmin Bank received notice of a complaint filed in the Seoul Central District Court by the Korean Government against Korea Lottery Services (KLS), Ernst & Young Hanyoung, Kookmin Bank and three individuals. The Korean Government alleges in the complaint that the defendants had agreed on a fee rate that was high, resulting in a reduction of 320,800,000,000 Won in contributions to the Lottery Fund. The Korean Government seeks damages of such amount plus interest from the defendants.
