On April 25, 2016, OceanFirst Financial Corp. (the Company) held a special meeting of its stockholders (the Special Meeting) in connection with the Company s previously announced pending merger (the Transaction) with Cape Bancorp, Inc. (Cape) pursuant to the terms of the Agreement and Plan of Merger, dated as of January 5, 2015, by and among the Company, Cape and Justice Merger Sub Corp. (Merger Sub).

<u>Proposal No. 1</u> Approval of the issuance of the shares of Company common stock in connection with the merger of Merger Sub, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, with and into Cape.

<u>Proposal No. 2</u> Approval to adjourn the Special Meeting, if necessary or appropriate, to solicit additional proxies in favor of Proposal No. 1.
