- (1) third tranche of performance-based restricted shares granted to the reporting person on February 27, 2015 pursuant to the Issuer's 2010 Performance-Based Equity Incentive Plan (the "2010 Plan").

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The award consisted of three substantially equal tranches and the amount initially awarded represented the maximum potential achievable number of shares.
