Implementation of SAP ERP – Enterprise Resource Planning System

Companhia de Saneamento do Estado de São Paulo – SABESP (“Company” or “Sabesp”), in its constant pursuit of improving operational efficiency, announces that it will implement the Enterprise Resource Planning – SAP ERP as of April 10. The system comprises a series of programs, integrating all information of the Company’s processes in a single data base.

With the implementation of SAP ERP, a system used globally by large companies, Sabesp will increase its operational automation and standardization through allowing access to a solid and robust base of corporate information, streamlining and optimizing management procedure, in line with the best market practices.

Given the complexity of the implementation of the system, which includes approximately 8,000 users and replaces 32 corporate systems, involving interfaces with various legacy systems, some instability may occur during the implementation process. However, the Company informs that it has been adopting the necessary measures to minimize these impacts.
